VISITOR POLICIES

- Please do not touch the exhibit panels, photos, artwork, frames, bases, walls, or protective coverings.
- Maintain a safe distance from all artwork and please refrain from gesturing near the artwork. We recommend 24".
- Food and drink are not allowed in Museum Galleries, Auditorium or Conservatory.
- ALL backpacks and large bags should be checked in at the Coat Closet during your visit.
- Children must always be accompanied by an adult and not left unattended.
- Strollers, small baby slings and front carriers are permitted, but we ask parents to be mindful of their surroundings.
- Please refrain from running, yelling or disruptive behavior.
- Weapons or firearms of any kind are not permitted on Museum Property.
- Smoking, including electronic smoking, is not permitted anywhere inside the Museum or the Courtyard.

PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

- Personal photography is allowed in the permanent collection galleries. This includes handheld cameras and cell phones that are set to take non-flash photos.
- Flash photography and selfie sticks are allowed.
- Photography in galleries with special/temporary exhibitions is prohibited unless noted otherwise.
- Artistic, Professional and Commercial Photography are permitted ONLY by appointment and with prior authorization from Museum Administration. Fees apply.
